Visitors

Visitors are welcome at all Lee Health hospitals. Seeing friends and family can be an important factor in recovery. We do ask that you limit in-room guests to two at a time. Visitor waiting areas are available throughout the hospital near most patient care and surgical areas. Visiting hours vary; please ask your nurse for visitation times on your unit.

Parking

Free parking is available in all patient lots. Handicapped parking spaces are also available in all of the parking lots.

Volunteers are available to transport you between the parking lot and the hospital in a golf cart 8 a.m.-4 p.m. Monday-Friday. Hours vary during the evening and weekends, and may change seasonally.

Cafeteria

The cafeteria is located on the first floor of the hospital and offers a wide variety of freshly prepared products. Selections are available from our grill, steam table, salad bar, deli, dessert, beverage and snack areas during the following hours of operation:

A coffee bar, ChocoLattés, is located in the main lobby. ChocoLattés serves locally roasted coffee and a variety of snacks. Hours are 6:30 a.m.–7:30 p.m. Monday-Friday, and 8 a.m.–7:30 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.

A Subway® is located in the Women's Services lobby. Subway is open 8 a.m.–8 p.m. Monday-Friday, 9 a.m.–7 p.m. Saturday, 10 a.m.–5 p.m. Sunday, as well as 11 p.m.–2:30 a.m. every night.

Tobacco Free Health System

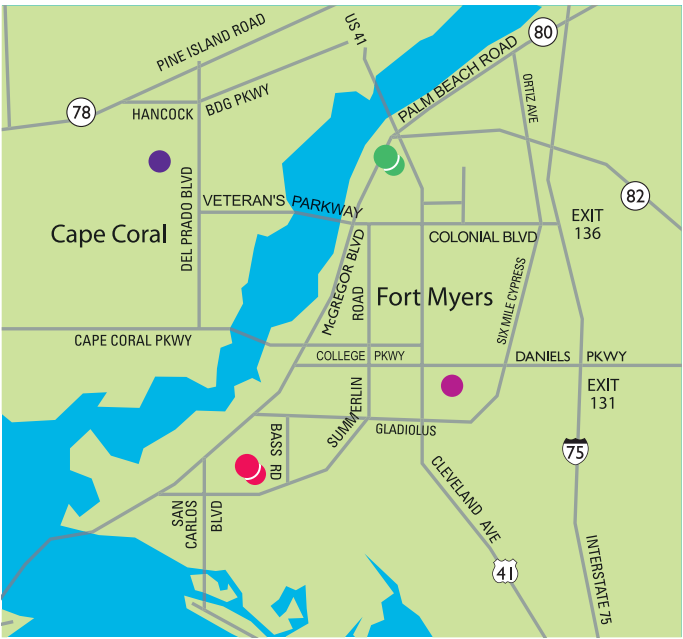

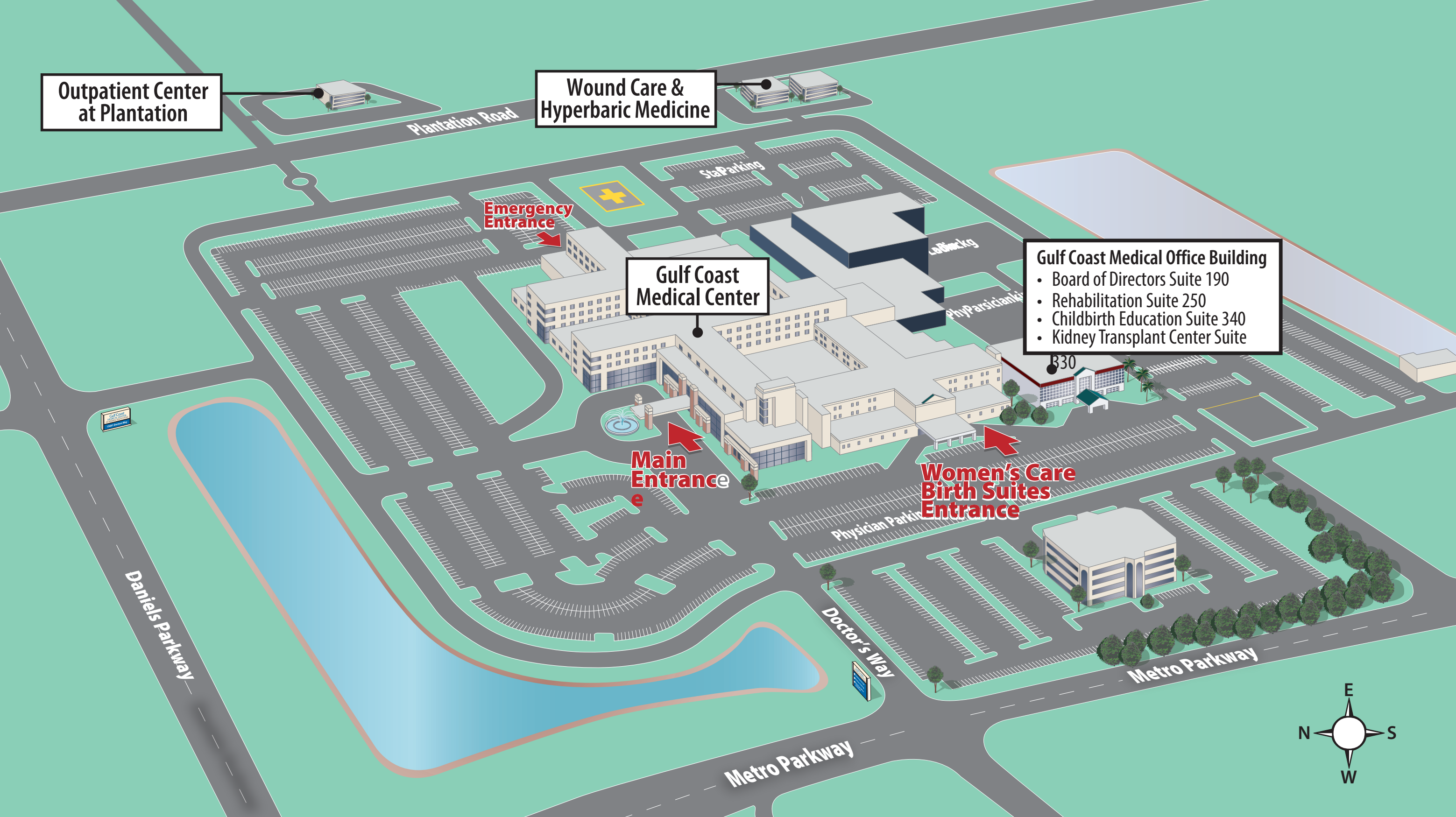
FACILITY MAP

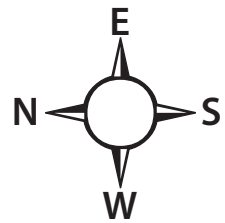




To Our Patients And Guests

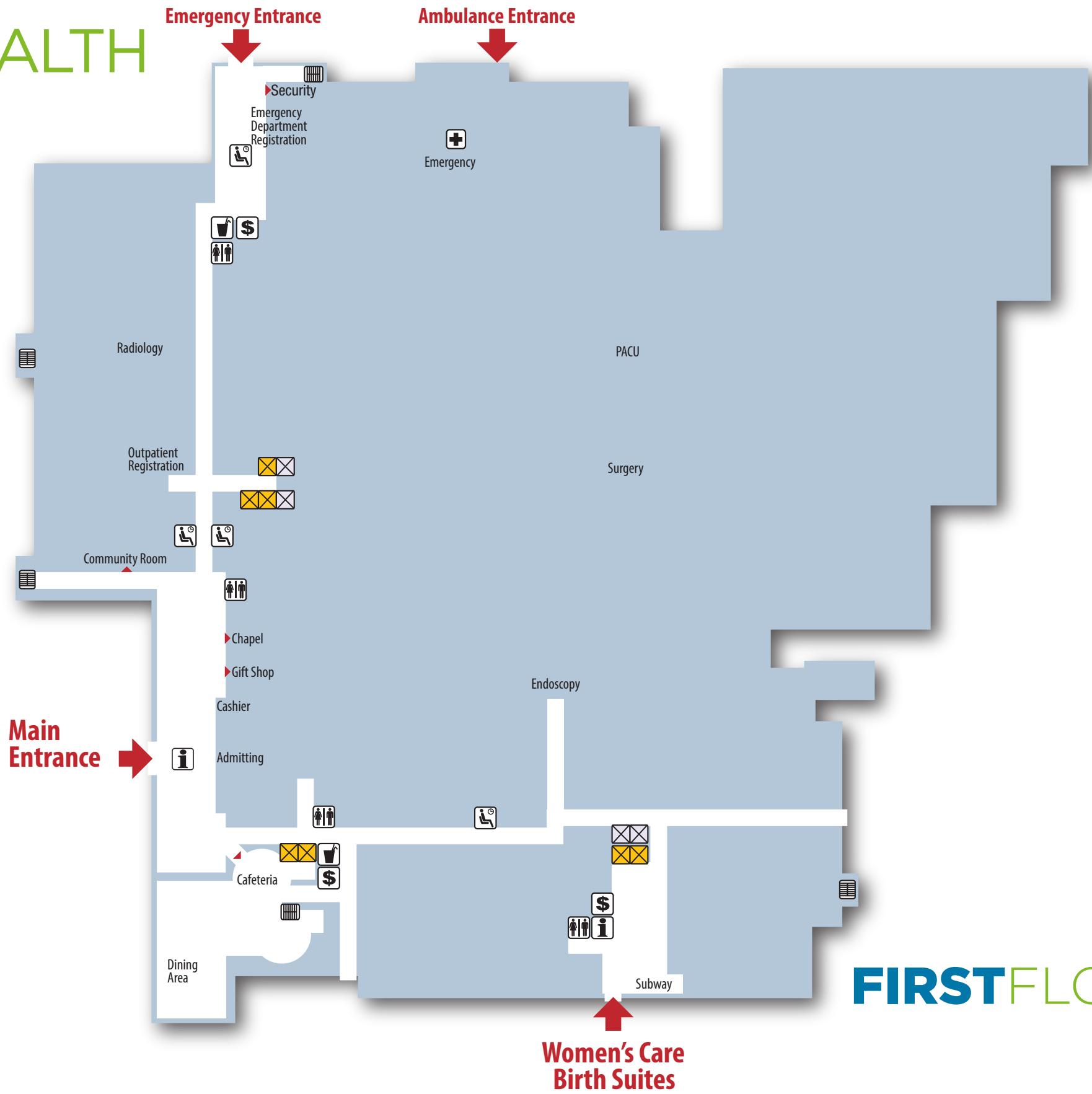

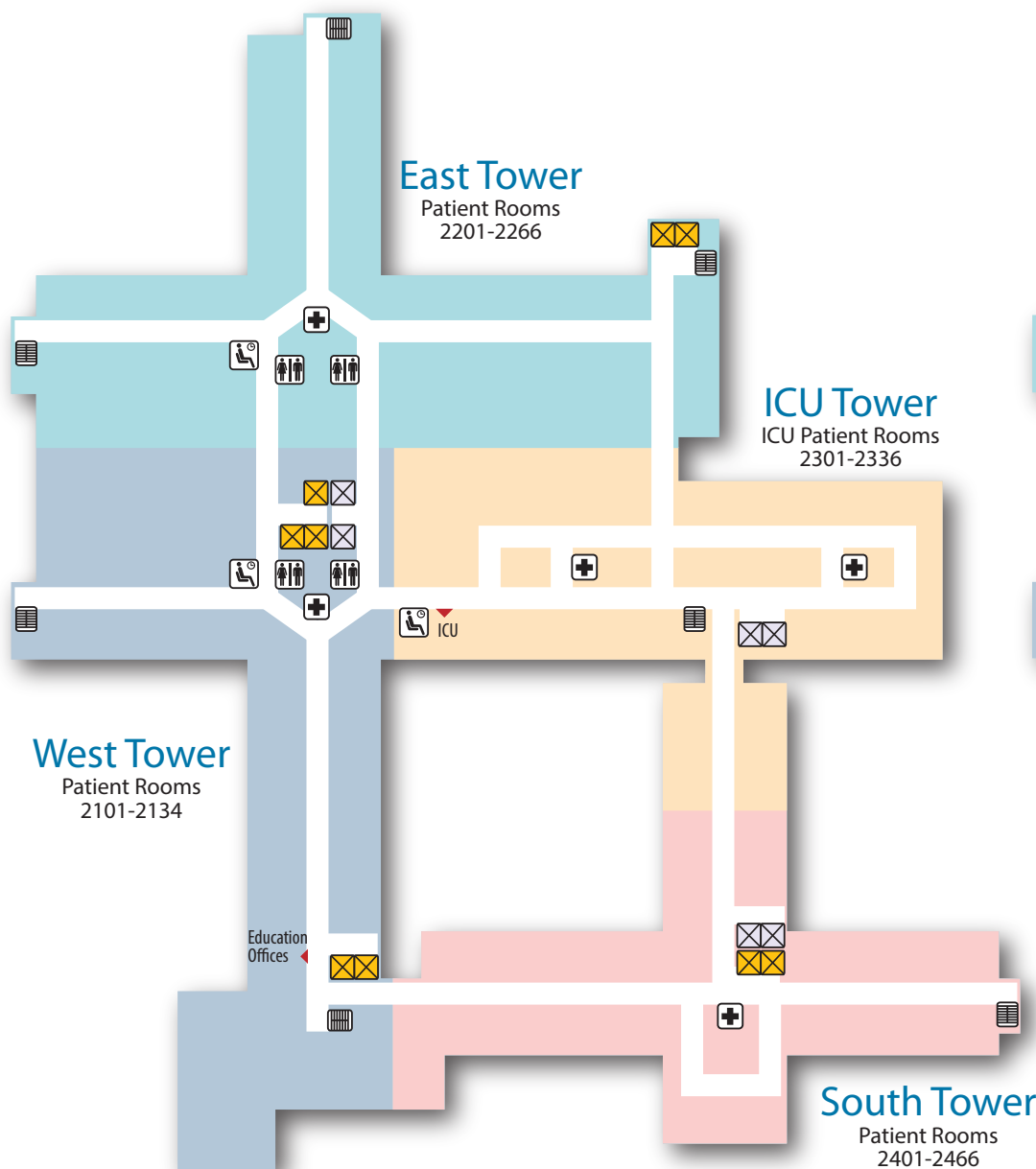

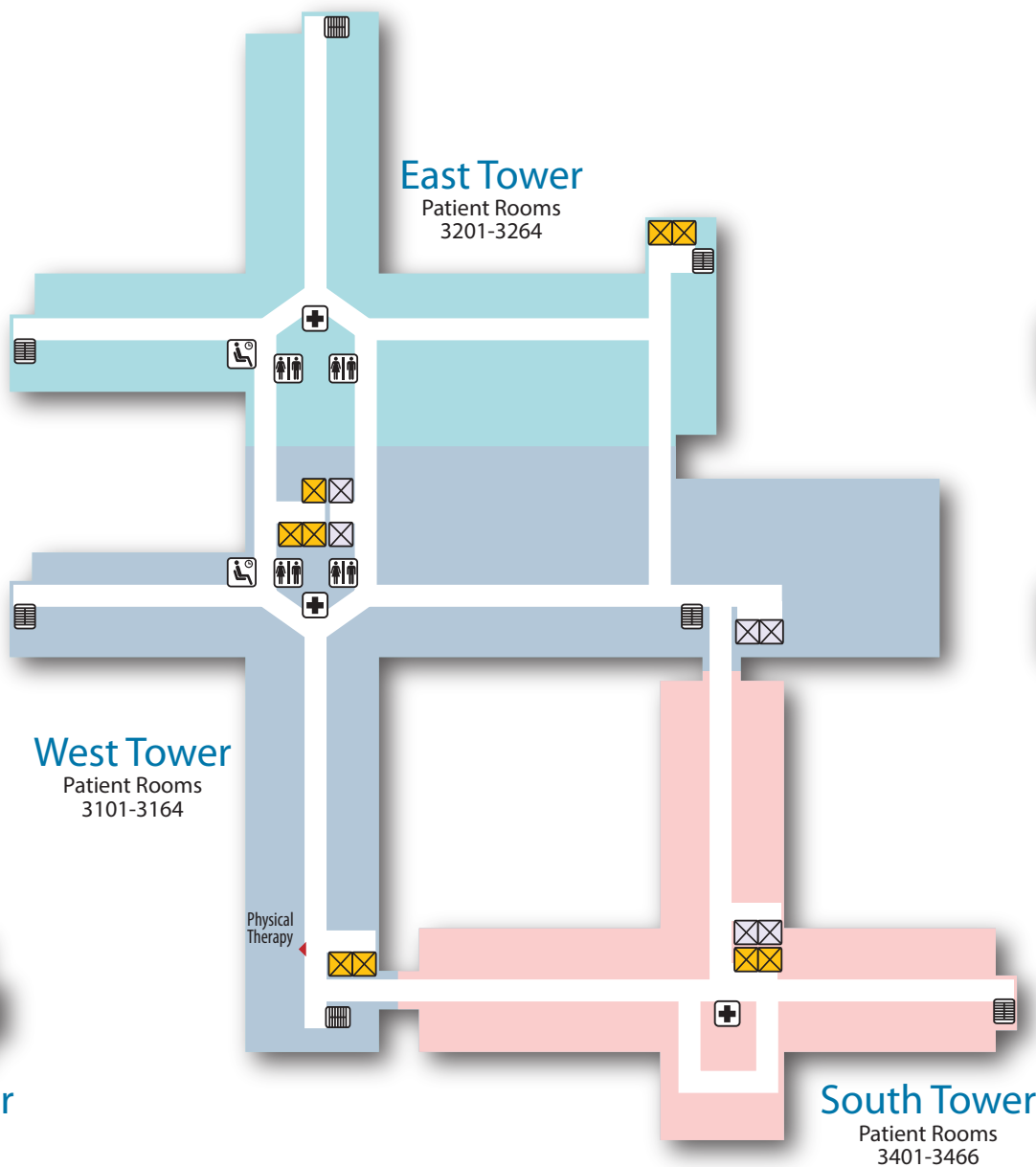
